

Hongyu Chen is a distinguished baritone from Inner Mongolia. He completed his PhD in vocal performance at the University of Arts in Belgrade and pursued advanced studies in Germany, earning a Konzertexamen (doctoral level) with distinction from the University of Music Saar. He also studied at the Mannheim University of Music, the Franz Liszt Academy in Weimar, and the Franz Liszt Academy in Budapest. His vocal training was guided by renowned teachers, including Eva Randová, Eva Marton, Krassimira Stoyanova, Rudolf Piernay, and Nikola Mijailovic. In recognition of his artistic and academic contributions, he was awarded an honorary doctorate (Doctor honoris causa) by Slobomir University in Bosnia and Herzegovina in 2023.

A multiple award-winner in international competitions, he has received top prizes at the International Antonín Dvořák Singing Competition, the Johannes Brahms Competition (Austria), the Ada Sari Competition (Poland), the József Simándy Competition (Hungary), the Imrich Godin Competition (Slovakia), UPMCF (France), the J.E.J. Reszkow Competition (Poland), the Romana Vaccaro Competition (Germany), and the Città di Alcamo Competition (Italy).

Hongyu has performed at prestigious venues such as Carnegie Hall, Frankfurt Opera, the Bayreuth Festival (Haus Wahnfried), the Tyrolean Festival, the Opéra-Théâtre de Metz Métropole, Nationaltheater Weimar, the National Theater Belgrade, and the Hungarian State Opera. His extensive concert engagements across Europe and Asia have led to collaborations with orchestras such as the German State Philharmonic Rhineland-Palatinate, the Brandenburg State Orchestra, the Prague Philharmonic, and the Orchester National de Lorraine, under the direction of eminent conductors like Christian Thielemann, Helmut Rilling, Gustav Kuhn, and Gyödi Sándor.

In addition to his performing career, Hongyu is a professor of voice at Inner Mongolia Arts University in China and was previously a lecturer at Szeged University in Hungary (2019–2023). He is a sought-after masterclass instructor across Europe and Asia and serves as an organizer and jury member for the prestigious Belvedere Singing Competition in Shanghai.
